3rd ISEA International Conference on Security and Privacy, Feb 27-Mar 1, 2020

Instructions and guidelines to fellows.

- 1. Fellowships are given to selected students /faculties from various engineering /science institutes in India in order to encourage them to attend the technical program of the ISEA International Conference on Security and Privacy. This will help them to understand the cutting edge research and product developments in this field. The keynotes and invited talks in this field will expose them with latest research trends. Such exposure will help them to further work on challenging problems in the field of information security and privacy. This should also be considered as a skill building exercise. Moreover, the conference provides an excellent socializing platform to interact with people working in this domain from across different countries.
- 2. Fellows are chosen after a competitive screening process based on past accomplishments, current research interests, and domain expertise of the candidates. Hence we hope that the selected fellows will do justice to the decision of the selection committee and make good use of the technical sessions of the conference.
- 3. Based on availability of funds and merit of the candidate, there are four types of fellowships awarded.
 - (a) FF: Full fellowship which includes free conference registration, travel and accommodation support/reimbursement.
 - (b) FP: Partial fellowship which includes free conference registration and free accommodation.
 - (c) FB: Basic fellowship which includes free conference registration.
 - (d) FS: Special fellowship which includes free travel and free accommodation.
- 4. Fellows have to attend tutorials and presentations on all days based on the topic of interest. Fellows have to mark their attendance on all sessions to the assigned coordinator.
- 5. It is imperative that the fellows attend the tutorials, main conference and Ph.D forum day (total 4 days). Lack of attendance may result is cancellation of the reimbursement of the registration fees and travel expenses. Kindly note that fellows have to plan their journey such that they IITG on or before 8 am 27.02.2020 to attend tutorials. Accommodation will be available from 26.02.2020 10 am onwards. They can leave only after 3 pm on 01.03.2020 from the conference venue. Late arrival and early departure request will not be entertained. In such cases, the fellowship committee reserves the rights to forfeit a partial amount of the registration fees.
- 6. Fellows have to bring the institute ID card during the time of registration.
- 7. Kindly quote your fellowship ID for all future correspondence.
- 8. The decision of the fellowship committee is final.
- 9. Read the guidelines and reimbursement policy regarding accommodation, travel support and registration given in the next page carefully. Submit the hard-copy of tickets and bills when you come for conference registration.

Accommodation support for fellows:

Candidates who got full/partial/special fellowship only are eligible for accommodation support. Only a shared accommodation in IIT Guwahati hostels/guest house will be provided to fellows.

Travel support for fellows.

Travel support is given to only candidates who have full/special fellowship. Such fellows are eligible for 3-tier AC train fare/AC bus fare from their place of study/home to Guwahati. Fellowship will cover upto a sanctioned amount for travel. However if the fellow is using any other mode of transport (by air, higher class trains) to reach Guwahati, actual fare or sanctioned money whichever is lower will be reimbursed. Reimbursement will made on the bank account within six weeks after the conference. Local taxi bills to/from railway station/bus station to/from home/college/hostel will not be considered for reimbursement.

Registration:

Candidates who are awarded with full/partial/basic fellowship need not pay the registration fee. However, if they have already paid the registration fee, it will be reimbursed after the conference.
