TEQIP conceived in pursuance of the NPE-1986 (revised in 1992) by Govt of India as a long term program to be implemented in different phases. After successful execution of TEQIP II. TEQIP III started from 2017-18 as Central Sector Scheme with a focus on the Low Income States, Northeast, Hill States and Islands. A total of 177 Engineering institutions and 14 Affiliating Technical Universities (ATUs) covering 1165 unaided institutions are selected for participation in TEQIP III. The third phase of TEQIP is also special in a way that it incorporates twinning arrangements between mentee & mentor institutions with an emphasis on Focused Training (PT) and Focused Interventions from IITs in terms of deliverables and accountability. Further, IIT Guwahati has been given a huge responsibility to mentor 12 engineering institutions of North East Region of India along with IIT Kharagpur.

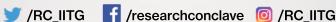


